 - Road improvements for Superior Township, Monroe County Road Commission, Dundee, Wayne, Kalamazoo, and Plymouth
 - Downtown street and streetscape improvements for Dexter, Elk Rapids, Fowlerville, Marquette, Scio Township and Wayland
 - Recreation improvements for Birmingham, Kalamazoo, and Wayne
 - Hospital facility improvements for Kalkaska County Hospital Authority
 - Various improvements for city facilities in East Lansing
 - A commercial paper program for Michigan State University
 - Refinancing existing debt for Kent Hospital Finance Authority (Spectrum Health), County of Calhoun Hospital Finance Authority (Oaklawn Hospital), and City of Iron River Hospital Finance
